"It is a global information database that will facilitate information exchange in the area of TCIM, and last but not least it will take part in establishing a safe space for communication with EBM," specified Tomas Pfeiffer. The whole project has been extensively discussed at a number of events dedicated to the problematics of TCIM, e.g. in the scope of negotiations in the European Parliament, WHO, British Parliament, Italian Senate, during negotiations with the organizations such as ANME (Association for Natural Medicine in Europe), EUAA (European Ayurveda Association), ISCMR (International Society for Traditional, Complementary and Integrative Medicine Research), and others. "The common goal of all of us actively working in the area of TCIM is to bring relevant information about this area to general public, and also to open a space for dialogue in the professional communities, i.e. in the area of EBM. Health knows no boundaries after all, so let's seek what unites us," concluded Tomas Pfeiffer, and he thus reminded the main idea of the whole Congress.

The interactive 3D Congress will be accessible even for the next 3 months after the end of the live event. Representatives of media will have the opportunity to present their information materials entirely free of charge.


